summer

PRUNE: *bay laurel • holly • hydrangea (after flowering) • magnolia • nandina (after flowering) • rosemary • rhododendron (after flowering) • skimmia • raspberry (after fruiting)* •

fall

PRUNE: *birch • camellia • crabapple • davidia • lavender (deadhead) • rhododendron • skimmia* • CLEAN: *gutters • garden beds* •
